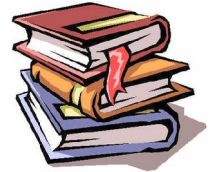


Year 3 Spring Term Curriculum Overview

Continuing in Year 3!

This year we have lots of exciting activities planned across the curriculum. Here's just a taste of what's to come.

In **English**, we will be looking at a wordless book, 'Chalk', thinking about and writing some words for each page of the story. The children will then try to come up with their own, similar story and then produce a wordless book of their own. We will then look at diary writing (recounts) and write what a Roman soldier's day is like.



In **Science**, we will be investigating magnets and how they affect themselves and other things around them. We will also look at friction and air resistance and how surfaces affect how a vehicle moves.

In **History**, we will be travelling back to when the Romans invaded Britain. Looking at what made them successful and what they brought with them, as well as their gods and traditions. We will make a Roman catapult and try to defeat our enemies to conquer them in **D&T**.



Our exploration of gymnastics and invasion games have already begun in **PE**, and we will all be super swimmers by Easter!

In **Art**, we will be drawing on our Roman experiences to make a variety of mosaics!



In **Geography**, we will be exploring Spain, its regions, cities, Madrid and what life is like for a Spanish child.

In **RE** we are investigation Christianity and whether the miracles were real? In **ICT** we will be perfecting our fundamental skills of word processing. The fun doesn't stop there.
