You have been in Class 1 for nearly a year and soon it will be time for you, your friends and classmates to move up into Class 2.

Mrs Bateman and Mrs Swinton will be the Class Teachers.

Mrs Bateman will teach on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday.

Mrs Swinton will teach on Thursday and Friday.



You will also have Teaching Assistants to help you in the class.

When you arrive at school, you will walk through the gate and meet with your friends at the front of the school. When the bell rings, you will line-up with your class and make your way into school via the blue door.



You will hang your coat, bag and place your lunch box in the cloakroom where you will find your name.



To begin with, you won't know where the equipment is kept, please raise your hand and ask if you need something. Some children may be worried that the work is going to be too difficult; the teachers will choose work that is interesting and achievable to all.





First thing in the morning, the teacher will take the register and then ask you what type of lunch you're having.

The menu will be the same as in Year 1 (meat/vegetarian/jacket potato) or if you wish, can bring in your own packed lunch from home.



The toilets will be located in the same place as in Year 1



Lunchtime - Classes finish at 12:15, you will then be given your meal token. You'll make your way straight to the hall, where the Midday Supervisors will direct you and your friends to a table, so that you can eat your lunch. Once you have finished, you'll go outside to play until the bell rings at 1.15pm. The whole school will line-up quickly and quietly in class order and then you'll walk back into class ready for the afternoon lessons.

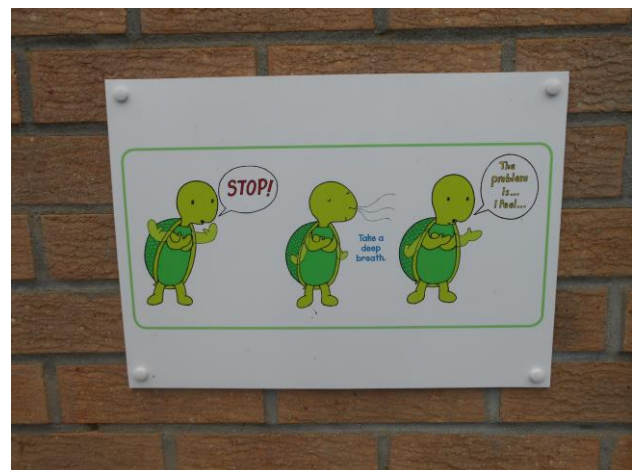
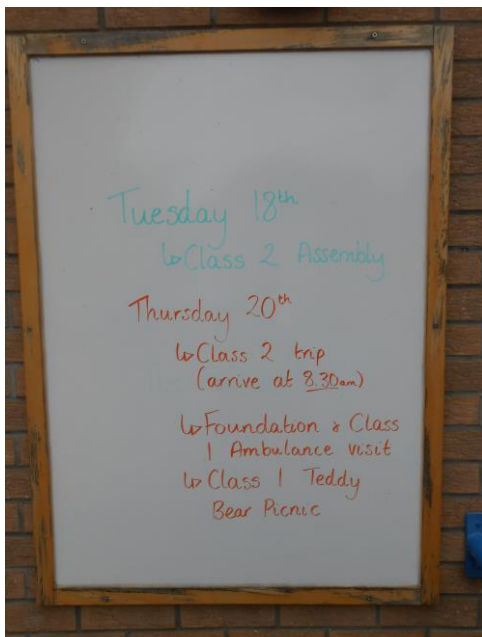
