You have been in Class 3 for nearly a year and soon it will be time for you, your friends and classmates to move up into Class 4.

Mrs Lockley and Mrs Axon will be the Class Teachers.

Mrs Lockley will teach on a Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday.



Mrs Axon will teach on Thursday and Friday.



You will also have Teaching Assistants to help you with your work.

Starting School in September.

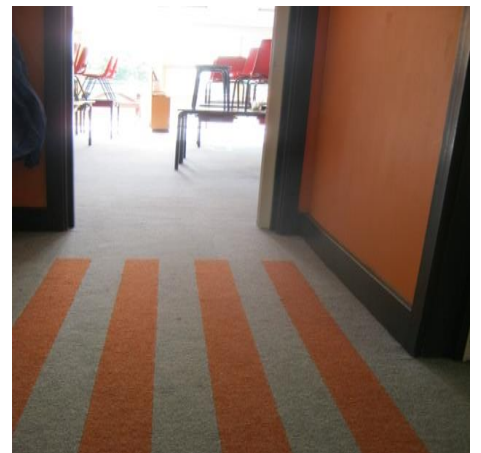
When you arrive at school, you will say goodbye to the adult you're with, walk through the side gate and meet with your friends on the terrace behind the KS2 classrooms.



When the bell rings, you will line-up beside the Orange Door of Class 4.



You will then follow the children and enter the school through the grey side door; hang your coat, bag and place your lunch box in the orange cloakroom where you'll find your name. You will then follow the orange lines on the carpet into the classroom.





Apart from the change in colour, the classroom looks the same as in Class 3, however to begin with you might not know where the equipment is kept.

Please raise your hand and ask if you need something. You may also bring in your own pencil case, not too big though, as it has to fit inside your tray.

Some children may be worried that the work is going to be too difficult; the Teachers will choose work that is interesting and achievable to all.

First thing in the morning, the teacher will take the register and then ask you what type of lunch you're having. The menu will be the same as in Class 3 (meat/vegetarian/jacket potato) or if you wish, you can bring in your own packed lunch from home.



There will be some homework in Year 4, but the teacher will explain to you what you have to do and when it should be brought into school.

The day finishes at 3.15pm; you collect your things from the cloakroom and wait for a Member of Staff to open the exit door.

This door must **only** be opened by a Member of Staff as it is alarmed.

You will meet your family member at the front of the school.



Although there are some changes as you move to Year 4, it is fine when you get used to it. Everyone is happy to help. So, if you are feeling anxious, just tell someone and they will try to help you to sort the problem.

Remember - you can use always your PATHS peg to show how you are feeling.
