<p><u>Maths</u></p>	<p>During this term the children will explore:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Fractions</b> - identify <math>\frac{1}{4}</math>, <math>\frac{1}{3}</math>, <math>\frac{1}{2}</math>, <math>\frac{2}{3}</math>, <math>\frac{3}{4}</math> of a number or shape, and know that all parts must be equal parts of the whole</li> <li>● <b>Measurement</b></li> </ul> <p><b>Length</b> - using standard units of measurement (centimetres - cm and metres - m) and using equipment such as rulers and metre sticks accurately.</p> <p><b>Time</b> - know the number of minutes in an hour and the number of hours in a day. Tell and write the time to nearest 15 minutes - quarter past/to the hour. (Extension - telling the time to the nearest 5 minutes)</p> <p><b>Mass, capacity and temperature</b> - using appropriate equipment and standard units of measurement to estimate and measure accurately (kg.g, litres/ml, °C). Compare and order measurements using the &lt;, &gt; and = signs.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Position and movement</b> - giving and following directions such as left, right, clockwise, anti-clockwise, quarter turn, half turn, three quarter turns and whole turn.</li> <li>● <b>Problem solving and effective strategies</b> - solving word problems including using pictorial representations. Using strategies such as drawing pictures, a number line and arrays.</li> </ul> <p><b>Home Learning:</b></p> <p>Please check Google Drive - Year 2. <p><u>Science</u></p>	<p>In the first half of this term, we will be learning about plants and how they grow and remain healthy. <u>Religious Education</u>	<p>Our topic is learning about Islam and the importance of the mosque. We will learn how praying and learning together can give a sense of belonging and community. <u>Geography</u>	<p>The children will be learning about the geographical features of the seaside, both human and physical. They will also be learning about seaside environments; finding out where they are located in the United Kingdom.
