You have been in Foundation for nearly a year and soon it will be time for you, your friends and class mates to move up into Class 1.

Mrs Gorman will be the Class Teacher.

You will also have a Teaching Assistant to help you in the class.

When You arrive at School in September.

When you arrive at school, you will walk through the gate and meet with your friends at the front of the school.

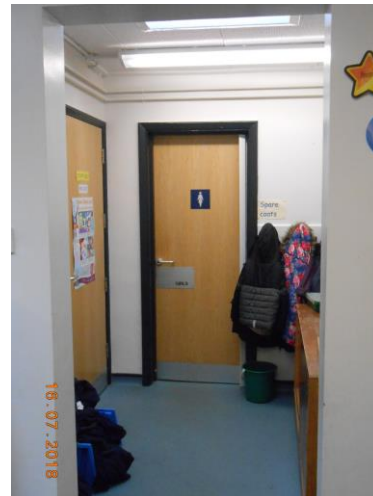




First thing in the morning, the teacher will take the register and then ask you what type of lunch you are having.

The menu will be the same as in Foundation (meat/vegetarian/jacket potato) or if you wish, can bring in your own packed lunch from home.

If you need the toilet during the day, they can be found in the KS1 corridor.



Lunchtime - Classes finish at 12:15, you will make your way straight to the hall, where the Midday Supervisors will direct you and your friends to a table, so that you can eat your lunch.

Once you have finished, you'll go outside to play until you hear the whistle at 1.15pm.

The whole school will line-up quickly and quietly in class order and then you'll walk back into class ready for the afternoon lessons.



Although there are some changes as you move up into Class 1, it is fine when you get used to it. Everyone is happy to help. So, if you are feeling worried, just tell someone and they will try to help you to sort the problem.

Remember - you can use your PATHS faces to show how you are feeling.
